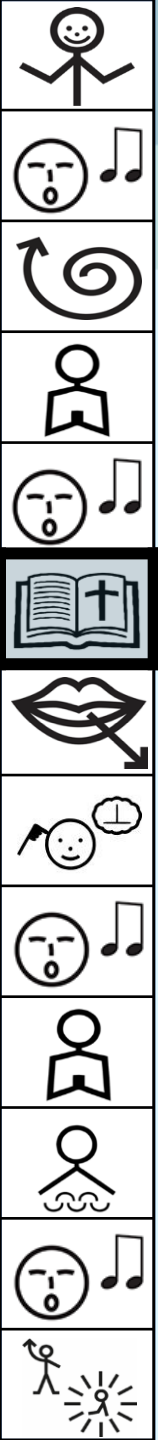
READING: JOHN 3:1-17

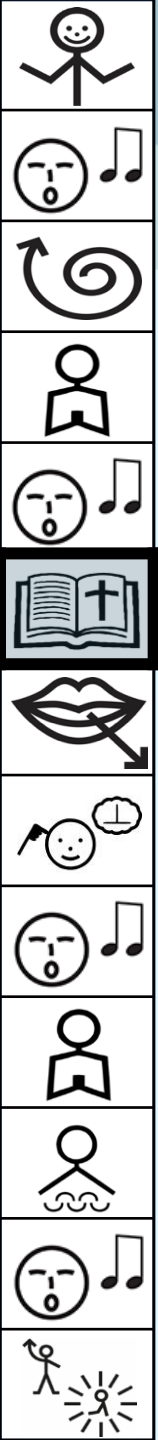
READING: JOHN 3:1-17

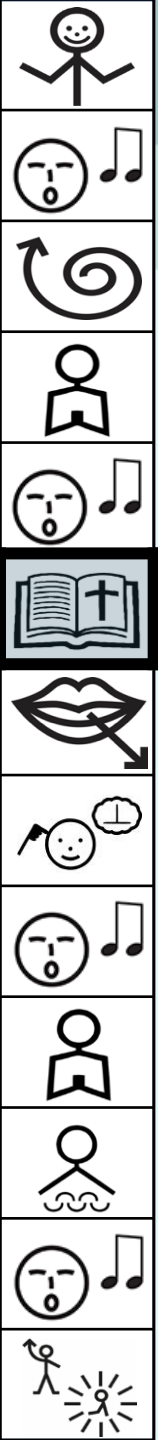
READING: JOHN 3:1-17

READING: JOHN 3:1-17

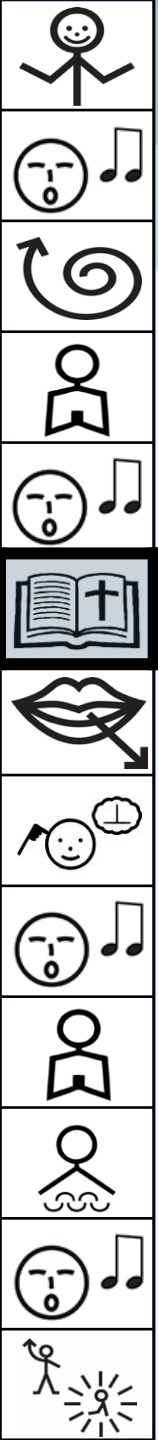

“Indeed, God did not send the Son into the world to condemn the world, but in order that the world might be saved through him.”

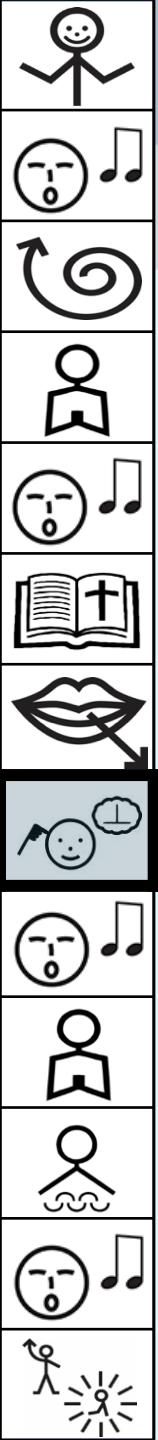

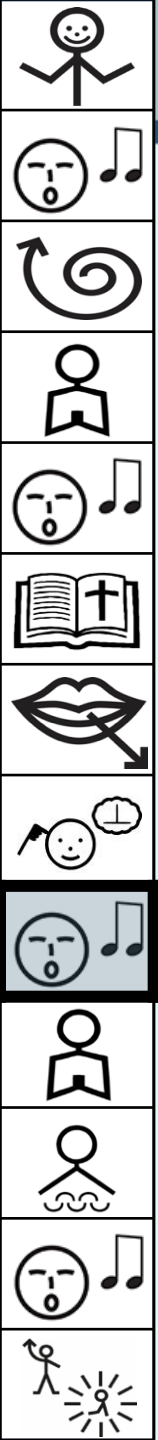



Before the throne of God above

With Christ, my Saviour and my God.

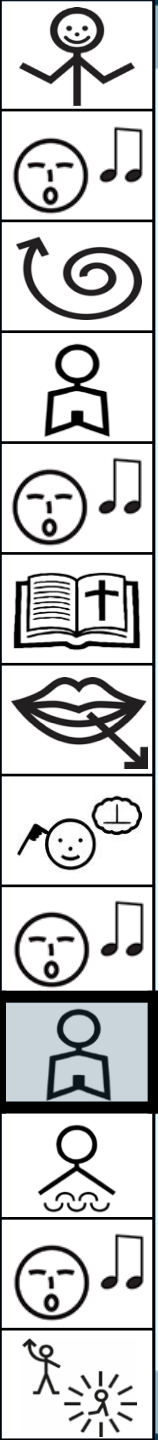




I bow before the cross of Christ,
